TRIO mentioned at the First National Conference on Promoting Active and Successful Ageing in Coimbra

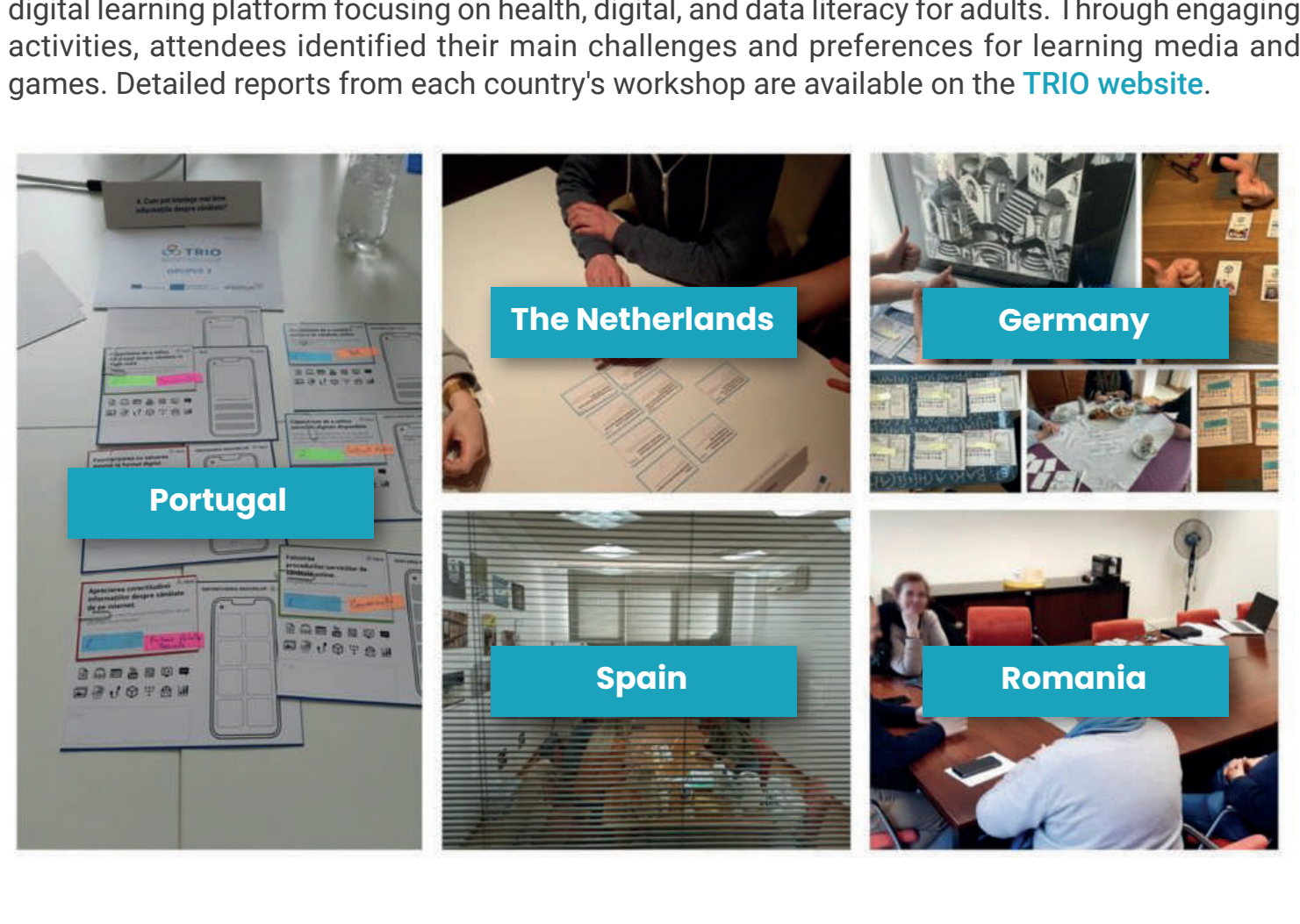
TRIO was one of the mentioned projects, where healthier living, participating ageing, citizen empowerment and adult education are focused.

TRIO co-creation workshops were completed in five European countries: Portugal, Spain, Netherlands, Germany, and Romania

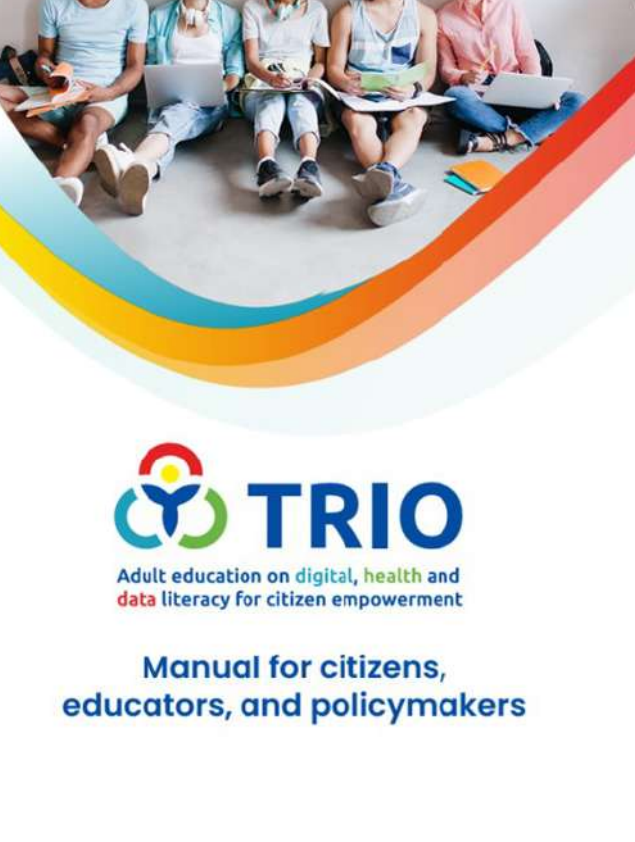
